PLANET OF THE APES RODDY McDOWALL DOUBLE CHIMP APPLIANCE

A set of foam makeup appliances made for the chimpanzee Cornelius, played by Roddy McDowall in Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1968). These unused appliances, marked as doubles, consist of an upper piece that includes the brow, nose, and upper lip and a lower piece that covers the chin and lower lip. These pieces, as they were during the production, are stored on a plastic shell vacuformed off of a lifemask of McDowall. These appliances were originally part of a collection gifted to the sister of makeup designer John Chambers. Accompanied by a copy of the film.

273 BENEATH THE PLANET OF THE APES GORILLA **COSTUME AND RIFLE**

A background gorilla costume from Beneath the Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1970). The costume consists of dark purple naugahyde vest with black stripes, a purple cotton long-sleeve jacket with matching pants, and a pair of cotton gloves with added naugahyde gauntlets that match the vest. The vest has a Velcro closure, the size "44" written in the collar, and a Western Costume label with the typed number "2431-1" attached. The shirt has a 44 size tag in its collar, and the pants have "WCC #33" inscribed in white marker. Also included is a handmade Ape rifle made of roughly hewn wood with an aluminum magazine insert and attached shoulder strap.



Ape appliance set made for Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1968]. Marked "BKO" for Buck Kartalian, the gorilla in charge of security at the animal hospital run by Dr. Zira, played by Kim Hunter. Directly from the collection of makeup artist John Chambers, who gifted it to his sister. This unused foam appliance was created for the film but not used, which accounts for its condition. The appliance is displayed, as it was on the set, on vacuformed lifemask of the actor portraying the character to help retain its shape. Accompanied by a copy of the film.

A set of four different ape appliance sets made for Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1968). The first marked "J. Wong G-I-New," a gorilla test appliance for Joe Wong, who was a test subject for many makeup and costume tests. Together with an unidentified partial gorilla appliance marked "LP.", an untrimmed background chimpanzee appliance marked "STCK." and an unidentified, possibly background orangutan and marked "A2-FC." These came directly from the collection of makeup artist John Chambers and were gifted to his sister. These unused foam appliances were created for the film but not used, which accounts for their condition. The appliances are displayed, as they were on the set, on vacuformed lifemasks of the actors portraying the characters to help retain their shape.

Ape appliance made for Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1968). Marked "WP" for Woodrow Parfrey, who played the orangutan Maximus, Commissioner for Animal Affairs. Directly from the collection of makeup artist John Chambers, who gifted it to his sister. This unused foam appliance was created for the film but not used, which accounts for its condition. The appliance is displayed, as it was on the set, on a vacuformed lifemask of the actor portraying the character to help retain its shape.

Ape appliance set made for Planet of the Apes (20th Century, 1968). Marked "BK" for Buck Kartalian, who played Julius, the gorilla soldier in charge of security at the animal hospital and who famously told astronaut George Taylor, played by Charlton Heston, to "Shut up, you freak!" before dousing him with a firehose.



The appliance is displayed, as it was on the set, on a vacuformed lifemask of the actor portraying the character to help retain its shape. Accompanied by a copy of the film.


