




CRASH LANDING!







SPACEMAN GEORGE TAYLOR!






FIRST SIGN OF LIFE!






MAN VS. BEAST!








ANOTHER PRISONER!


NOVA IS CAPTURED!

The girl is then forced into a crude horse-drawn wagon.








PLANET OF THE APES CAPTURED!




THE VICTORS!







PROUD CONQUERORS!


"SAY CHEESE!"


APE SURGEON!




TAYLOR'S LIFE IS SAVED!


PLEADING FOR MERCY!








WORDS OF ANGER!







HUMAN ON A LEASH!







RETURN TO PRISON!







APE SCIENTIST!









ZOO ATTENDANT!







WATER TORTURE!







THE TRIAL CONTINUES!






DECIDING TAYLOR'S FATE!


ESCAPE!





"UNDER ARREST!"
