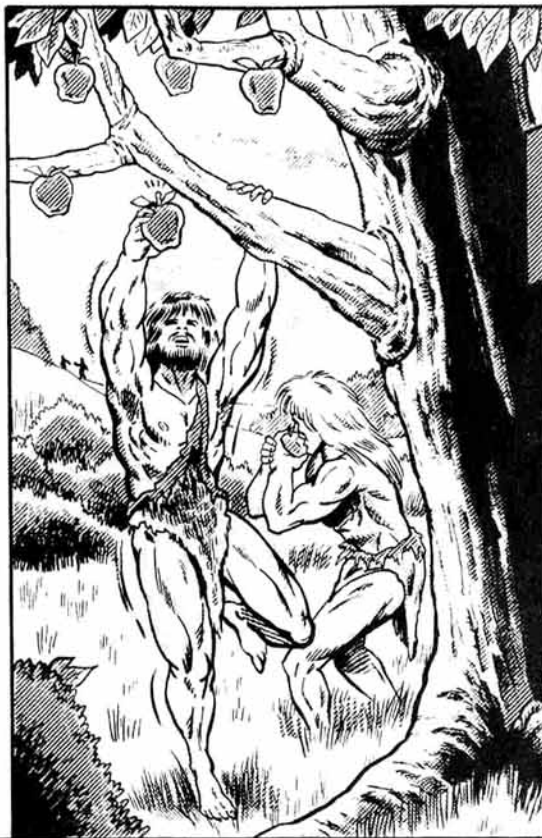

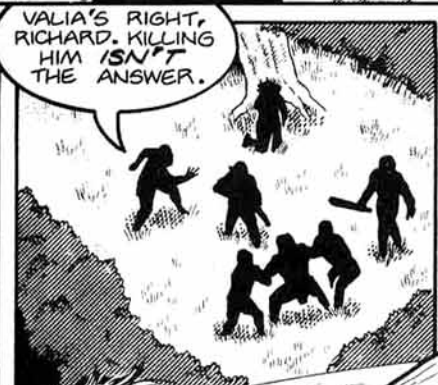






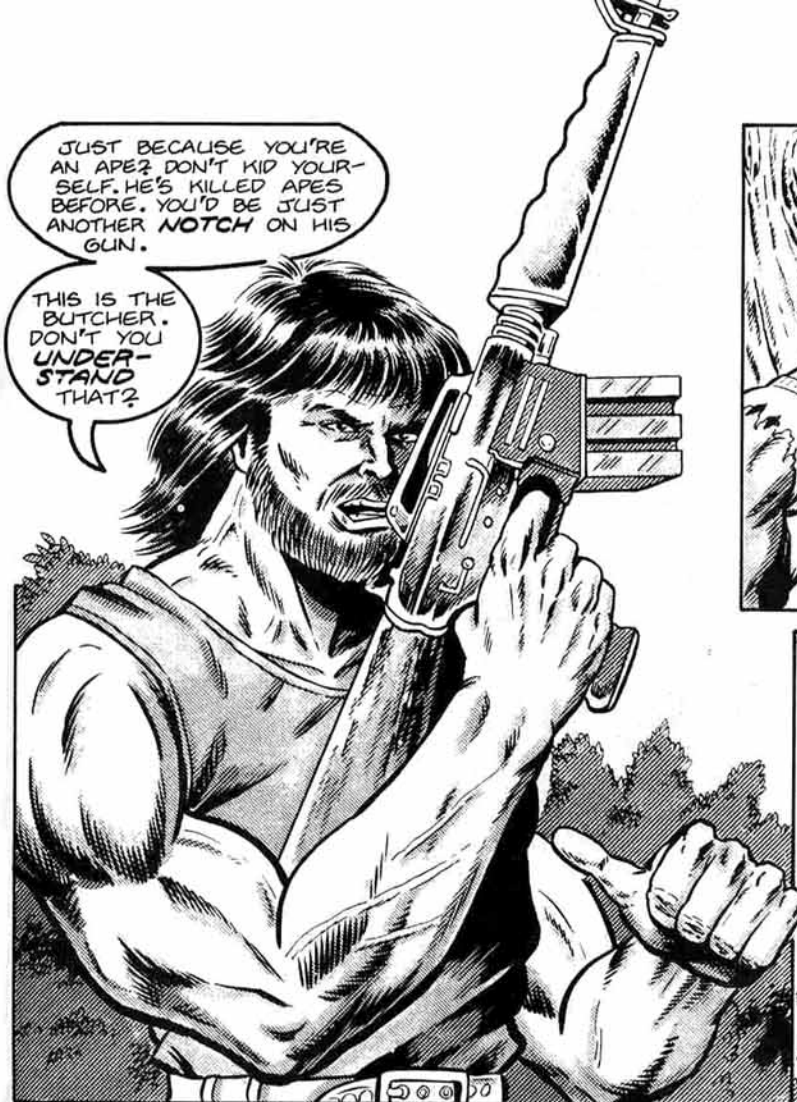
















# CHAPTER NINE
