

Real to Reel:  
How the real-life locations  
of New York City  
were portrayed on screen  
in  
Beneath the Planet  
of the Apes

As we know at the end of Planet of the Apes astronaut George Taylor finds out that he is not on an alien planet but, is in fact back on Earth. He of course realizes this when riding along the shoreline with Nova and comes across the remains of the Statue of Liberty.

Beneath the Planet of the Apes takes up where Planet left off and we are introduced to a new astronaut...Brent who was sent to find out what happened to Taylor.

Brent of course meets up with Nova, who leads him to, a city of Apes after which into the Forbidden Zone where he to finds out that he also is back on earth and more specifically a nuclear ravaged New York City.

So, how does the movie locations of New York City compare with the real locations?

Let's take a look at this journey...Beneath the Planet of the Apes.

As we know Brent and Nova first make their way into NYC by entering the Queensboro Plaza Subway station and then from there they make their way by tunnel to Manhattan.

They enter Manhattan from Queens via a tunnel and come out at 5th Ave and E. 41 St outside the main branch of the NYC Public Library.



In the reel picture above we don't see much of the surrounding area but we do know that from the lion and stairs that it is the main branch of the library. We see that the tunnel actually takes up most of 5th Ave, which we can only assume was done sometime before or maybe after the nuclear war. Looking south on 5th Ave.

The pictures on the right are the real locations of the area. Accuracy between the reel and real is low but close enough to portray where the two are.

**Location: New York City Main Library Branch  
476 Fifth Ave NY, NY**





The picture above shows the front of the main branch of the library from the movie.

And it lines up pretty well with the actual look of the main library branch below.



For those interested the two lions in front of the library are named Patience, which guards the south side of the library's steps and Fortitude which guards the north.



Brent and Nova continue their journey and come upon Radio City Music Hall.  
Located at the corner of 6th Ave and W. 51 Street.



Above is the movie version of Radio City Music Hall.

Accuracy is pretty decent especially with the façade showing that it is Radio City Music Hall.

location: 11 Wall Street NY, NY**



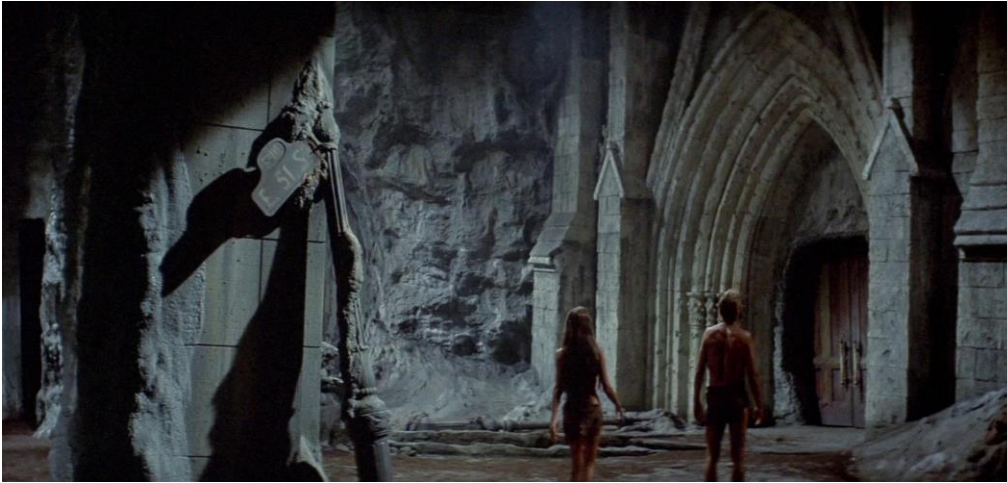
Brent and Nova make

**Location: 5th Ave between E. 50 and E. 51 Streets**



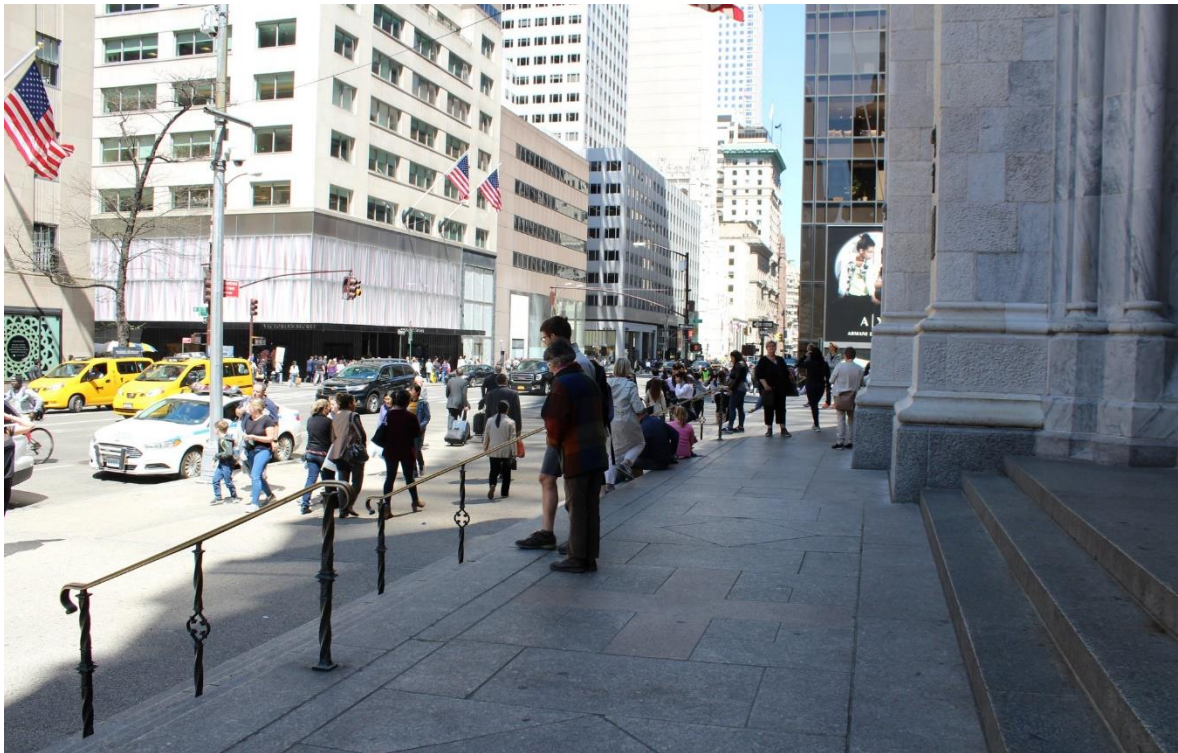
As with the top photo from the movie, depending on your point of view or position, either of the above street signs would work. 5th Ave is the dividing point for East and West streets.

Below the same view looking north on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave



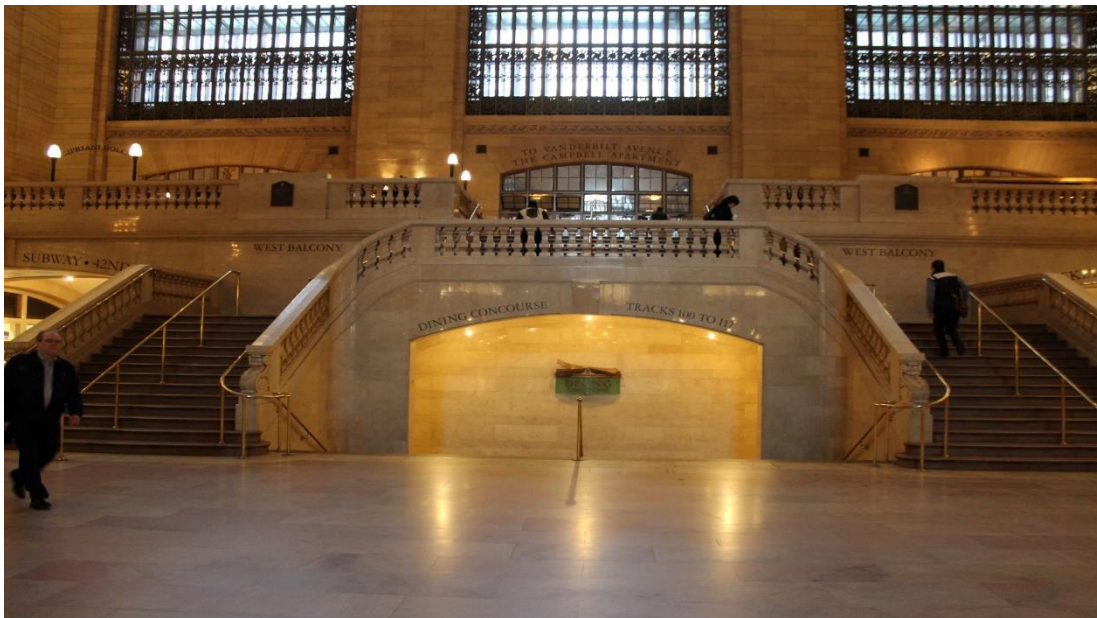


Brent meets his interrogators in Grand Central Terminal

This stairway is located on the Vanderbilt Ave exit on the west side of the Terminal.

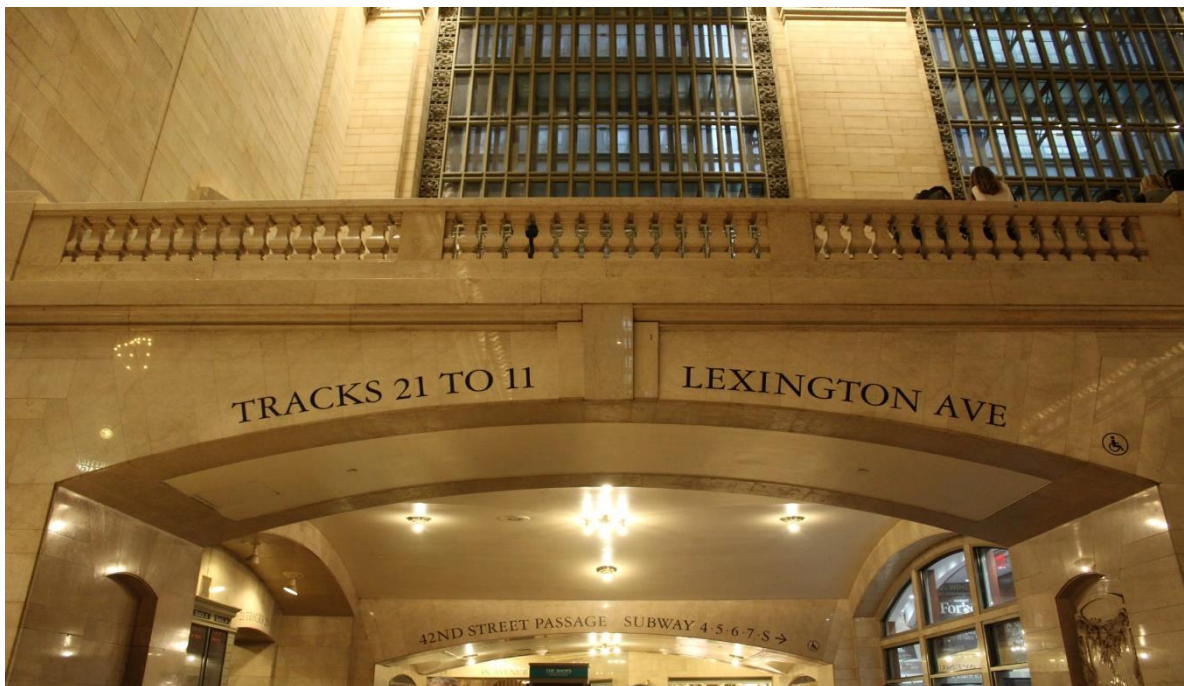


**Grand Central Terminal location:

TRACKS 19-11 LEXINGTON AVE SUBWAY TELEPHONES  
This would put his interrogation on the main floor of the Terminal.

We now get to the worshipping of the Alpha Omega bomb which takes place inside of the ruins of St. Patrick's Cathedral.

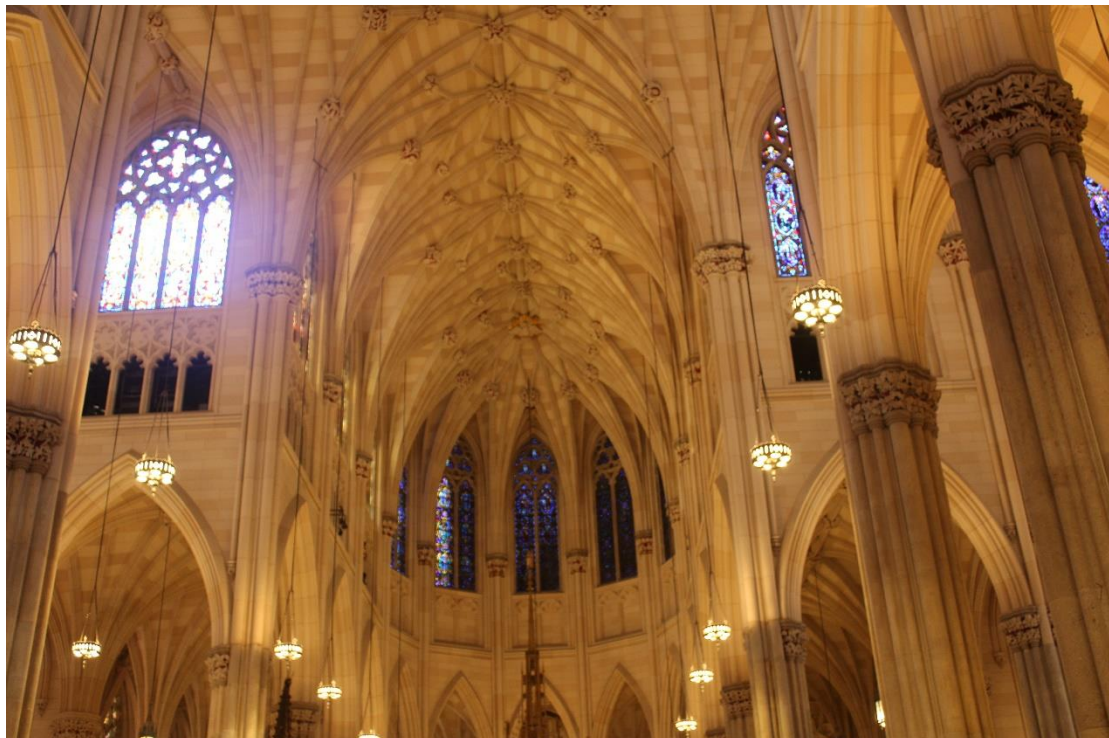
Below is when Brent first enters the cathedral and meets Verger.



Below is the real location of where the Alpha-Omega bomb would be located.



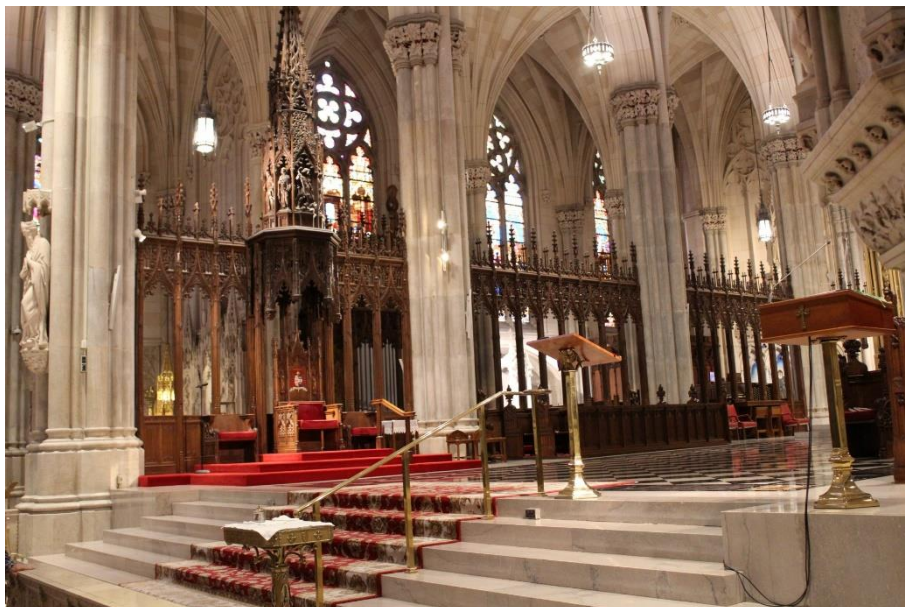
The below picture is looking up to where the Alpha-Omega bomb would have been launched.
