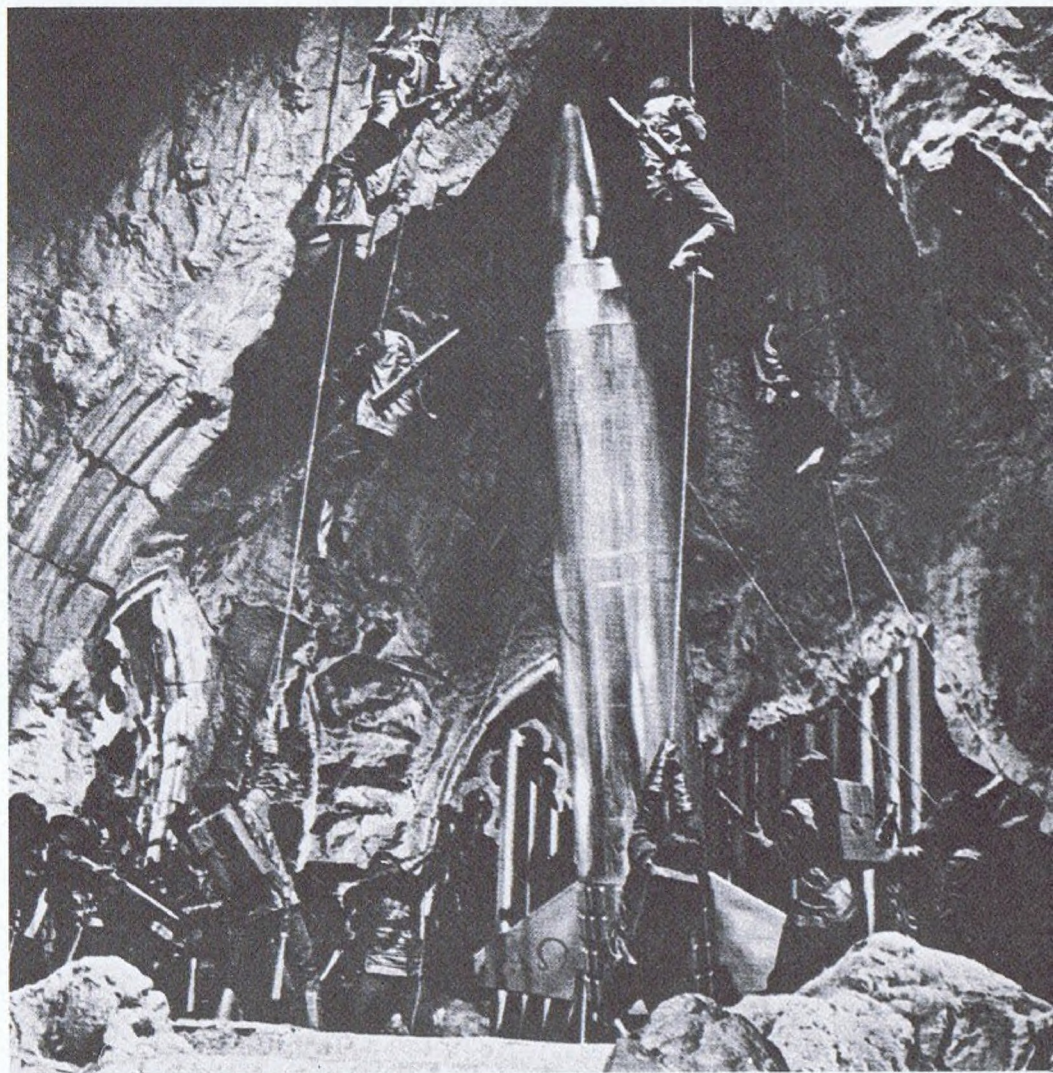
WEAPONS
